## Website Information

When you visit https://uckfieldmillenniumgreen.co.uk we use analytics to collect standard log information about you and general details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out how many people visit the site. We collect this information in a way that does not identify anyone. We do not seek to link that information to anyone or use it in any other way.

## How we store your personal information

All contact details are stored securely and are available to a limited number of trustees in order to carry out the above tasks.

# Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including: Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification – You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.
